



EXECUTIVE ORDER BY THE GOVERNOR

**AMENDING THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE WORKING GROUP TO STUDY AND
MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING THE ISSUE OF
METHAMPHETAMINE USE IN NEVADA**

WHEREAS, a Working Group to study and make recommendations concerning the issue of methamphetamine use in Nevada was formed by Executive Order on January 22, 2007, and amended by Executive Order on February 13, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that "The supreme executive power of this State, shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, this Executive Order is hereby issued and the dissolve date of the Working Group shall remain in existence until May 31, 2009. The Working Group shall issue a second report and recommendation, including recommendations for Legislative action, to the Governor by December 31, 2008. The Working Group will present their December 31, 2008 report to the Legislature during the 2009 Legislative session. The Executive Orders of January 22, 2007, and February 13, 2007, are in all other ways unchanged and remain in full force and effect.
